NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The City Commission of the City of Weston proposes to adopt the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 1.01, "DEFINITIONS," TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "COVERED INDIVIDUAL;" AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, CREATING SECTION 72.10, "PARKING ON PUBLIC PROPERTY," TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADDITIONAL PARKING PROHIBITION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY CHARTER BY AMENDING SECTION 2.06, "COMPENSATION; REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES;" TO PROVIDE FOR A SALARY INCREASE FOR THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS AND AN ANNUAL INCREASE BASED ON THE FEBRUARY CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (CPI) FOR THE MIAMI-FORT-LAUDERDALE AREA; PROVIDING REQUISITE BALLOT LANGUAGE FOR SUBMISSION TO ELECTORS; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF ENABLING RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY CHARTER BY AMENDING SECTION 2.03, "ELECTION AND TERM OF OFFICE," TO ELIMINATE TERM LIMITS FOR THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS; PROVIDING REQUISITE BALLOT LANGUAGE FOR SUBMISSION TO ELECTORS; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF ENABLING RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A Public Hearing on the Ordinances will be held by the City Commission Monday, July 3, 2017, and a Second and Final Hearing will be held Monday, August 21, 2017, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The City Commission may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time certain without further notice provided the date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinances in their entirety may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk during regular working hours.

Persons wishing to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such hearing will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.
