



GET YOUR YELLOW DOT IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Broward County Rolls Out New Program to Aid First Responders

When you can't speak for yourself, who will speak for you? Yellow Dot can help first responders in the event of an automobile crash or medical emergency when individuals are not responsive. The program is designed to share critical information with law enforcement, fire rescue and emergency medical personnel in the event of a vehicle emergency.

How Does Yellow Dot Work?



A Yellow Dot decal displayed on your car's rear windshield or in a clearly visible location on your

motorcycle alerts emergency responders to look for the Yellow Dot pamphlet in your car's glove compartment or a compartment attached to your motorcycle. The information you provide in the pamphlet will help emergency responders determine whether you have a pre-existing medical condition and will help determine how to treat you if you are not able to communicate after an accident.
