To Be Eligible To Vote

If you are eighteen years old, a U.S. citizen, and legal resident of Florida you may register to vote. If you are sixteen years old, you may pre-register and receive your card in the mail after your 18th birthday.

You are NOT entitled to register to vote if you have been adjudicated mentally incapacitated with regard to voting in this or any other state and you have not had your right to vote restored pursuant to law, or, if you have been convicted of any felony by any court of record and you have not had your right to vote restored pursuant to law.

If you meet the above requirements, you may register to vote in Broward County either by using the online voter registration form or in person/telephone.

Facts About Voting Voter Identification Requirement

In order to vote at the polls during early voting or on Election Day, you must show a photo and signature identification. Acceptable forms of photo identification include: Florida driver license (quickest to process), Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway, Safety and Motor Vehicles (quickest to process), U.S. passport, Debit or credit card, Military identification, Student identification, Retirement center identification, Neighborhood association identification, or Public assistance identification. Identification must be current & valid. If your photo identification does not contain your signature, you will be required to show an additional form of identification that provides your signature.

MYTH: The address on the driver's license must match the address in the voter registration record in order to be able to vote.

FACT: The address on the driver's license does not need to match the address in the voter registration record. If you have moved and haven't changed your driver's license to reflect your new address, that's okay. What is important is that you vote in the precinct where you currently live, no matter what your driver's license says.

MYTH: If a voter does not have a driver's license, the voter cannot vote.

FACT: In order to vote at the polls during early voting or on Election Day, you must show a photo and signature identification. Acceptable forms of photo identification include: Florida driver license (quickest to process), Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway, Safety and Motor Vehicles (quickest to process), U.S. passport, Debit or credit card, Military identification, Student identification, Retirement center identification, Neighborhood association identification, or Public assistance identification. Identification must be current & valid. If your photo identification does not contain your signature, you will be required to show an additional form of identification that provides your signature.

Please note: I.D. is not required for persons who cast an absentee ballot. However, the signature on the voter registration database is compared to the signature on the voter's certificate envelope. The two signatures must match.

First of two Weston Proposed Charter Amendments as it will appear on the ballot:

Compensation for Mayor and City Commission

Since 2002, the current City Charter has provided for Commissioners to be compensated at the rate of \$10,000 per year and the Mayor to be compensated at the rate of \$13,000 per year. The proposed amendment would increase salaries to \$12,300 and \$16,000 per year, respectively, effective on December 1, 2018, to be increased annually on December 1, based on the annual change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
