SAFEGUARD YOUR PROPERTY BY PROTECTING YOUR POOL

HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS – A Continuing Series

Before hurricane season begins, there are steps that you can take to reduce damage to your home and property. The first step is to walk around your property and look for vulnerabilities.

Protect Your Pool

- Keep water in the pool as it will protect the pool's finish from sand and flying debris. You may lower the water level, but no more than one to two feet. Otherwise, hydrostatic pressure could cause the pool to pop out of the ground.
- Add extra chlorine to the water to prevent contamination.
- Turn off the power to the pool equipment.
- Remove the pool pump motor and store it indoors in a dry place, or wrap the motor in a plastic material such as a garment bag and secure it tightly with tape or rope.
- Remove all loose items from the pool area (furniture, pool cleaning equipment, filter house tops, deck lids, etc.).
- After the storm, reinstall pump, return water level to normal; clean pool thoroughly; balance the pH, super-chlorinate, and run the filter until the water is clean.

Weston Kitchen Fire Put to a Quick Stop

Thanks to the quick action of approximately two-dozen firefighters from Broward Sheriff's Office Fire Rescue, a house fire was contained and no injuries were reported. First responder crews from Weston were on scene at 16871 Patio Village Ct. in less than four minutes, on July 19, 2010, to find a kitchen fire ablaze in the one-story home. The residents weren't home when the fire, that left severe smoke damage, began. The Broward Sheriff's Office Fire Marshal's Bureau is looking into the cause of the fire.

While kitchen fires are all too common, there are ways to avoid having this happen in your home.

- Always keep things that burn easily away from your cooking area
- Never leave cooking area unattended
- Keep any cords on top of countertops
- Always replace damaged cords or appliances



One of the best ways to avoid a house fire is to have properly working smoke alarms throughout the house. Smoke alarms save lives, prevent injuries, and minimize property damage by enabling residents to detect fires early in their development.

Pet "Snack Shacks"

Residents Encouraged to Donate Food for Homeless Animals

Broward County Animal Care and Regulation has launched a pet food donation drive July 19 through August 31, 2010.

Broward County Animal Care shelters, feeds and cares for more than 20,000 lost and surrendered animals each year.

"Pet Snack Shack" collection boxes are located at Animal Care's adoption centers in Fort Lauderdale and Pompano Beach, Broward County library branches, courthouses, and other government buildings, including the governmental centers in Fort Lauderdale and Plantation.

An unfortunate side effect of the economy has been an increase in pet surrenders from families who no longer have the resources to properly care for their animals.

All donations received in the Pet Snack Shack drive will go to feed and nurture the dogs and cats at the Broward County Animal Care shelters. Many are lost and anxiously awaiting a reunion with their owner. Others are hopefully awaiting adoption by a new forever-friend or family.

<u>Suggested items for donation include</u>: cat and dog food (canned or dry, pop-top cans preferred), cat and dog treats, and cat litter.
