



WESTON UNIVERSITY PROGRAM STARTING THE CLASS OF 2012

The City's unique Weston University Program is starting its ninth year of providing select high school students with an in-depth and personalized civics education. Established in 2002, each year a total of 24 students, sophomores, juniors and seniors, are selected from Cypress Bay, Sagemont and Western High Schools.

The program is a combination of classroom instruction and conversations by senior city staff; appointed and elected officials including the City Manager, City Attorney, the Mayor and other guest speakers; and hands-on exercises and field trips.

Students meet once monthly for seven months, for a full school day. Each monthly program day is at a different city department, exposing students to the operations of their municipal government and career paths in both public and private services. 

WESTON COMMUNITY CENTER CLASSES SAT PREP COURSE

BROWARD COUNTY TO HOST FREE 2011 EXPORT READINESS SEMINAR

The Broward County Office of Economic and Small Business Development is presenting the 2011 Export Readiness Seminar, a three-part educational series designed to help companies grow through realizing their export potential. The sessions are open to the general business community at **no cost**. All 3 sessions (listed below) will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Broward College, 111 East Las Olas Boulevard, in downtown Fort Lauderdale (metered parking is available in the City of Fort Lauderdale Parking Garage).

The Export Readiness Seminar is designed as an introduction to exporting for Broward County companies. Upon completion, participants will be able to determine their firm's readiness to export, conduct market research to identify desired markets, understand the basics of developing an export plan, comply with regulations of both the United States and the receiving country, and access resources for export guidance.
