Construction Update

Since February 27, 2014, Peace Mound Park has been undergoing construction improvements that are starting to reflect the new appearance designed for the park.

Some of the construction work in progress includes:

- Walkway elevations being finalized
- Relocation of trees
- Improved shading towards the north end of the park by trees being positioned specifically for maximum coverage
- Preparation for concrete to be poured for new stairs that will lead from the parking lot to the playground
- Site work for a larger playground with rubber surfacing that will provide for excellent accessibility for visitors in wheelchairs, crutches, strollers, etc.
- Removal of the wooden bridge along with examination of the structure to make sure it is sound before installing the new decking

URGE SUPPORT OF AFFORDABLE FLOOD INSURANCE RATES

Weston's Assistant City Manager/Finance Director David Keller is urging homeowners to call or email their U.S. House Representative and urge them to vote YES on the Homeowner Flood Insurance Affordability Act of 2014, supporting affordable insurance rates for residents.



The bill (H.R. 3370 as amended) contains measures to stop or slow skyrocketing flood insurance premium rate increases for some properties called for by the Biggert-Waters Act of 2012

(BW-12). The intent of the Act was good. It was aimed at assuring the solvency of the National Flood Insurance Program, requiring FEMA to adjust flood premiums to reflect the true flood risk. The amended legislation (H.R. 3370) will delay the implementation of rate increases until FEMA completes the affordability study and to undertake any other such amendments to BW-12 that will keep flood insurance rates affordable for primary, non-primary and business properties while balancing the fiscal solvency of the program.

The Biggert-Waters Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2012 (BW-12) is a law passed by Congress and signed by the president in 2012 that extends the National Flood Insurance Program for five years, while requiring significant program reform.

Florida has more than two million National Flood Insurance Program policies meaning Floridians will be hit hard by the Biggert-Waters Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2012 due to the dramatic flood insurance rates that are coming as a result.

NAVIGATING A ROUNDABOUT

Roundabouts are constructed to slow traffic and make roadways safer for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. Here is a reminder of the protocols and traffic laws regarding the use of a roundabout.

Vehicles

1. Yield at Entry

As you approach there will be a yield sign and dashed yield limit line. Slow down, watch for pedestrians and bicyclists, and be prepared to stop if necessary. Yield to circulating traffic on the left, but do not stop if the way is clear.

2. Slow Down

Drive at a slow speed through the roundabout. The posted speed limit in the roundabout is 15 mph.

3. Yield to Pedestrians

Pedestrians have the right of way as in any other marked crosswalk.

4. Yield to Bicycles

Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities as motorists when in the roundabout. Do not turn in front of a bicycle when exiting the roundabout.

5. Yield to Emergency Vehicles

Pull over **after** exiting the roundabout. Do not stop while still inside the roundabout.

Pedestrians

1. Use Roundabout Crosswalks

Walk around the perimeter of the roundabout, using the crosswalks. Do not cross the roadway to the central island.

2. Watch for Traffic

Look and listen for approaching vehicle traffic and bicycle traffic.

Choose a safe time to cross. Try to make eye contact with approaching drivers.

Bicycles

1. Ride with Traffic

While roundabouts do not have striped bike lanes, traffic moves slowly, allowing cyclists and motorists to more effectively share space. Merge into the appropriate travel lane as you approach the roundabout, proceed through the roundabout, and merge back onto the shoulder the after exitina roundabout.

2. Share Sidewalk with Walkers

The roundabout has a wide sidewalk for cyclists and pedestrians to share. Cyclists must yield to pedestrians on the sidewalk.

WESTON CLEVELAND CLINIC

Participates In Largest Nationwide
Alzheimer's Disease Prevention Trial



Researchers at Cleveland Clinic in Weston are participating in a new clinical trial designed to test the effectiveness of using a currently-approved diabetes drug to prevent the development of Alzheimer's disease in people who are predisposed to develop the condition.

The trial is called TOMMORROW, a

Phase 3, double-blind, placebo-controlled study and is the nation's largest prevention clinical trial for Alzheimer's disease.

The trial examines if the drug pioglitazone (AD-4833), currently FDA approved to treat Type 2 diabetes, reduces inflammation and has a protective effect in the brain that can prevent high risk-patients from developing mild cognitive disorder and Alzheimer's disease.

This trial is an example of a repositioning project, where researchers take an approved drug and study it in a new use or condition.

Researchers at Cleveland Clinic will screen hundreds of people with the goal of enrolling about 120 participates.

- Participates must be cognitively normal, exhibiting no symptoms of memory impairment, and between 65-83 years old.
- All participates must undergo a genetic blood test, which will determine if the individual has a higher or lower possible genetic risk to develop the disease.

Alzheimer's disease is an incredibly important health issue especially with Florida being home to nearly 10 percent of individuals in the United States who suffer with the disease, and, with a large senior population, it's an ideal community to draw participates for this trial.
