CHLORINATION WATER TREATMENT

Monday, November 16th – Monday, December 7th

The City of Sunrise maintains the highest quality standards to provide clean, safe drinking water to its customers, which includes the City of Weston. From **November 16th through December 7th**, the Sunrise Utility Department, which provides water to the City of Weston, will use a temporary free chlorine treatment process in the water system to provide additional protection against bacteria.



What is Chlorination Water Treatment?

This temporary treatment of the water system is a common practice for water suppliers that use a chlorine treatment method. This periodic program is recommended by the Florida Department of Health.

This procedure does not cause any adverse health effects. However, some individuals may notice a slight change in the taste, odor or color of the water during this time.

Special Considerations: Kidney dialysis centers, nephrologists and hospitals have been notified in order for them to make any adjustments necessary in the various processes which they operate. Any questions regarding kidney dialysis should be directed to the user's doctor or dialysis specialist.

Some aquatic and marine animal species are sensitive to free chlorine; persons maintaining aquariums with any sensitive species may wish to contact their pet supply stores regarding dechlorination.

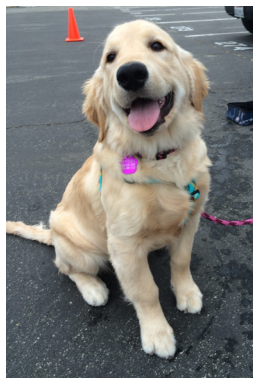

A space for dogs to play leash-free

YES, PETS ARE PEOPLE, TOO! ... BUT REMEMBER TO FOLLOW CITY REGULATIONS



We love our pets here in the City of Weston. Dog lovers and cat lovers alike, as well owners of all other types of pets, should all be aware of the regulations that pertain to pet ownership in our City. The City's Code on Animal Care and Regulation (Ch. 53) refers to the [Broward County Animal Care Ordinance](#).

Here are a few friendly reminders for Weston residents:

- **Dogs must be on a leash in public areas**
It is against the law for any dog to be at-large. Dogs cannot freely roam in a neighborhood, community, park or any open area. Dogs must be under the owner's control by either a leash, cord, chain or confined to the property by a fence. Dogs found to be at-large may be impounded at the Broward County Animal Care shelter.
(Broward Co. Code Sec. 4-3)
- **Pick up after Dogs and Cats**
Taking Fido on a walk? Pet owners must pick up after dogs and cats in any public swale, sidewalk, park or right-of-way, and on any private property not belonging to the owner. (Broward County Code Sec. 4-8)
- **Annual Rabies Vaccination**
All cats and dogs four months and older must be vaccinated against rabies every year by a licensed veterinarian. (Broward Co. Code Sec. 4-10)
- **Annual County Registration**
Every cat or dog in Broward County must have and wear a Broward County Rabies Registration Tag that is renewed annually. *(Broward Co. Code Sec. 4-11)*



BROWARD'S NEIGHBORHOOD WATER CHALLENGE



Residents Can Win \$1000 Cash or a New Water-conserving Irrigation System for Water Conservation and Outreach

In the past four years, Broward residents, non-profits and businesses have saved millions of gallons of water through the BWP's ConservationPays program. Now, residents in participating partnership communities are eligible to participate in this year's Neighborhood Water Challenge.

Participation Categories:

- **Water Conservation**
Teams of neighbors (2 – 5) can get together to conserve water.
- **Outreach and Education**
Contestants will develop and implement an outreach program to help their neighbors understand that conservation and reuse are more than saving water; it's about using all of our water resources wisely.

First place winners will receive \$1000 cash. The second place prize is a state-of-the-art water-conserving irrigation system.

The contest is sponsored by Broward Water Partnership, WaterReuse Florida and WaterOptimizer and ends May 31, 2016.

Contest Details:

Water Conservation

In the water conservation competition neighbors will work together to save water over a two-month period. Water savings will be determined by comparing bills from 2015 to 2016. An average savings for each team will be calculated. The team that saves the most wins. Each household in the winning team will receive \$1000 cash. Each household on the second place team will receive a state-of-the-art Water Optimizer irrigation system.

Outreach and Education

A single resident or family can sign up to create an outreach and education plan to promote conservation and the value of using all of our water resources (the right water for the right purpose).

Contest runs through May 31, 2016.

CLEVELAND CLINIC FLORIDA KEEPS ON GROWING

Cleveland Clinic Florida Opens New Interventional Radiology Annex

In October, administrators and caregivers at Cleveland Clinic Florida gathered for a celebratory grand opening of the new 7,600-square-foot imaging annex on its Weston campus.

Housing three interventional radiology suites, the annex features two single and one biplane angiography suite with DynaCT capabilities that include state-of-the-art imaging. The suites will allow neuro-interventional radiologists to treat acute strokes and cerebral aneurysms. Interventional radiologists will also be able to minimally invasively diagnose and treat vascular aneurysms and blockages, liver tumors, other forms of cancer and uterine fibroids.

At the upcoming December 7, 2015 Weston City Commission meeting, Cleveland Clinic representatives are scheduled to make a presentation regarding future expansion plans in Weston.
