Lieutenant William 'Bill' O'Brien of the Broward Sheriff's Office was recently recognized by Sheriff Scott Israel for 40 years of service protecting the residents of Broward County. Lt. O'Brien continues to protect and serve the public today. Assigned to the Weston District since 2007, Lt. O'Brien began his career as a Police Officer in the City of Pompano Beach in 1975. He worked road patrol, tactical enforcement, criminal investigations Detective, Vice & Narcotics – including smuggling operations with DEA and Customs Enforcement. He was promoted to Sergeant in 1984 and then to Lieutenant in 1988.

In 1999, the City of Pompano Beach merged with the Broward Sheriff's Office. Lt. O'Brien's career continued in Pompano Beach, then on to Watch Commander at the Ft. Lauderdale/Hollywood International Airport. Lt. O'Brien came to Weston in February of 2007, where he has been Watch Commander ever since, with assignments as Officer In Charge of Criminal Investigations and the Community Strategies Team.


FULL NIGHTLY CLOSURE 1-75 SOUTHBOUND AT ROYAL PALM BLVD.

SCHEDULED FOR MARCH 23RD, MARCH 24TH & MARCH 27TH 10:00 PM - 5:30 AM

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to close lanes on I-75 **southbound at Royal Palm Boulevard** to install an overhead sign structure for the 75 Express Project. In order to perform the work safely, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

All lanes of I-75 southbound at Royal Palm Boulevard will be closed nightly from 10:00PM to 5:30AM on Wednesday, March 23 and Thursday, March 24. Closures will continue on Sunday, March 27th.

Motorists will be able to take the exit ramp to Royal Palm Boulevard (Exit 15), go west on Royal Palm Blvd. to Weston Road, go south on Weston Road to Griffin Road. Go south on Griffin Road and then take the entrance ramp to re-enter southbound I-75 at Griffin Road.

NEW WALKWAYS COMPLETED AT COUNTRY ISLES PARK Park Is Now Open

Enjoy a walk in the park at Country Isles Park. The park recently underwent a walkway renovation, whereby all of the asphalt walkways that surround the perimeter of the park were replaced with an 8-foot wide concrete walkway.

Concrete walkways have a longer lifespan, require much less maintenance over time, can be cleaned easier and provide for a safer, sturdier walking surface.

LAKEVIEW DRIVE SIDEWALK INSTALLATION PROJECT

March 28 - May 11, 2016

The City of Weston will construct a sidewalk on the west side of Lakeview Drive from SW 168th Terrace to Saddle Club Road. The project construction, along with restoration of swales disturbed during the installation, will take place beginning March 28, 2016 with an anticipated completion date of May 11, 2016. The completion date is always dependent upon Mother Nature and any weather related delays.

The project will include:

- Removal of 49 Queen Palm trees along west side of Lakeview Drive. Trees will be replaced and new locations will be determined by Landscaping Department.
- Drainage catch basin adjustments.
- Sidewalk installation: 1600 linear feet of 5 foot wide concrete sidewalk.
- Restoration of swale areas disturbed during installation.



This sidewalk installation will provide additional safety for school children and residents who reside in homes located on SW 4th Court, SW 169 Avenue and SW 168 Terrace. Currently pedestrians must cross Lakeview Drive at these intersections to gain access to the sidewalk on the east side of Lakeview Drive, to walk or bike to Saddle Club Road.
