WHAT'S NEW @ THE PARKS? NEW PLAYGROUND AT EMERALD ESTATES PARK





Check out the newest playground in Weston! It took just over one month to transform the playground at Emerald Estates Park into a state of the art play area with new elements like the *Sway Fun* rocking bench (see below) that can be enjoyed by children and adults and is wheelchair accessible.

There are two separate play areas intended for ages 2–5 and 6–12. The play structures contain

details such as gears, tracks for Matchbox-style cars and realistic wildlife molded into the cave climbing structure.

HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE ARE YOU PREPARED?

Hurricane season begins tomorrow – June 1st – so now is the time to prepare your home, family and business in the event that a storm would threaten to impact our area.

WHY PREPARE NOW?

It only takes one storm to severely impact your life and the community at large. South Florida learned that lesson when Hurricane Andrew – the first storm of the 1992 season – impacted the region in August of that year. Preparing your plan and purchasing supplies for your home in advance helps minimize last-minute chaos, so that you can focus on securing your home and assisting loved ones as needed. Imagine if everyone waited until the last minute to purchase supplies – stores would be grid locked and supplies would run low. Unfortunately, this mayhem is common because of the surge of shoppers that wait until a storm is headed our way to purchase necessary supplies.

WHAT DO YOU NEED?

Visit Westonfl.org/Hurricane to find out what you should have in your **personal Disaster Kit.** You should have enough supplies to sustain your family for 3 – 5 days following the storm. Basics include non-perishable foods, bottled water,



medicines, baby formula/diapers, battery-operated radio and flashlights.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE BY THE NUMBERS

2016 Participation in Household Hazardous Waste Collection and Electronics Recycling



If sustainability was a race, Weston is well on its way to victory. In collaboration with Broward County, the City recently held its second annual Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics collection event, which was a major success with 487 participants (472 from Weston).

January's event brought out 903 Weston residents (935 participants overall).

Collectively, the average amount of waste each person brought to May's event was 66 pounds; which is roughly the same weight as a bag full of concrete. The City as a whole has saved the Earth from 1.2 tons of CO2 emissions in the last year from waste collection alone, demonstrating a united effort to reduce the carbon footprint.

Weston residents are major contributors to the waste collected through Broward County's ongoing Household Hazardous Waste program, representing a large portion of what was collected overall. If you missed the 2016 events held in January and May of this year, do not fret! Broward County is committed to this effort all year long. Weston residents can access any of Broward County's Household Hazardous Waste drop-off sites, which open on Saturdays throughout the year. In the first quarter of 2016, 319 Weston residents dropped items off at the sites. Click here for more details.

Residents are encouraged to take full advantage of these types of services and programs offered by Broward County and the City of Weston. Small efforts like recycling regularly at home and recycling bulk trash items

can make a significant difference in the impact we make on our planet.






SAFE SELLING TRANSACTION ZONE A LOCATION FOR ONLINE BUYERS/SELLERS

A model program, COP's are the additional eyes and ears of the community, assisting and enhancing our own BSO policing efforts. Members of the Broward Sheriff's Office Countywide Operations professionally train all volunteers. Typical assignments in addition to patrol, include performing checks on unoccupied residences at owner's

request, checking on elderly or homebound and reporting potential problems and neighborhood hazards and assist at Weston community events.
