Aside from electing our nation's next president, voters will vote on representatives at the state and local level, as well as **local referendum questions**. City of Weston voters will select a new Commissioner for Seat 1, and will also have an amendment to the City's charter for consideration. Click here for the details on the City of Weston's election.

On the November 8th ballot, voters throughout Broward County will find two questions relating to a half-penny sales tax increase to fund city infrastructure projects and a half-penny sales tax increase to fund Broward County transportation projects.

WESTON REGIONAL PARK Parking Lot Resurfacing Project

All parking area surfaces and the asphalt walking/jogging paths within the Weston Regional Park will be milled and paved in a resurfacing project underway within the park.

Residents and visitors will see heavy equipment and trucks staged within areas of the park. The contractor, Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., will be phasing the project and working closely with Weston Public Works, Parks & Recreation and the Weston YMCA to minimize or prevent interruption of park or YMCA services. The project currently underway, dependent upon weather, is anticipated to be completed by December 16, 2016.

Included within the project are the installation of tree root barriers, the replacement of damaged curbs and reinstallation of parking and traffic pavement markings. This will be the first time since its opening in 2000, that the entire Regional Park parking lot has been resurfaced.

The Weston Regional Park, is located at 20200 Saddle Club Road, Weston.

BSO SHRED-A-THON AND OPERATION MEDICINE CABINET

Saturday, November 12, 2016 from 10 AM - 1 PM 17300 Royal Palm Blvd. Weston, FL



The Broward Sheriff's Office will hold a Shred-A-Thon and Operation Medicine Cabinet prescription drug "take back" event on Saturday, November 12th in Weston.

The prescription drug take back program, operating under the name Operation Medicine Cabinet, allows participants to turn in unused or expired prescription medication to receive a \$5 gift card (while supplies last, limit one per family).

The Shred-A-Thon provides residents with a safe way to dispose of their personal documents, check stubs, credit card offers, receipts and any other paperwork that contains sensitive information. The service is free of charge. There's a limit of five boxes per person.

Boxes can be no larger than 15" L x 12" W x 10" H

Documents destroyed at BSO's Shred-A-Thon events are shredded by SafeGuard Document Destruction.

This will prevent your car from locking AND give thieves access to drive your vehicle away. With visitors arriving from out of town: ensure children are safe and cannot access pools and waterways.

PLAN FOR A WATER SAFE HOLIDAY

Tropical weather year-round allows us to enjoy the outdoors in all seasons. If you plan to have family visiting from out of town for the holidays, plan ahead to ensure for all to safely enjoy water activities – from swimming in a backyard pool to beach time or boating.



Planning a family gathering for the holidays? Having out of town guests during Thanksgiving or Winter Break? Review your water safety plan - especially if you will have children in your home. It's easy for adults to let their guard down during large social gatherings.



Learn CPR

Because seconds count in a potential drowning situation, it is important to learn CPR. Free CPR certification courses are offered to all Weston residents by BSO Weston Fire Rescue. For details, call 954-389-2015.

Water Safety Tips

SUPERVISION

Nothing takes the place of a designated adult to watch the water when children



are in and around pools or lakes. The Water Watcher should be responsible for actively watching the water at ALL times and commit to the task rather than using the time to use the phone, text, or socialize. Resist the urge to put the responsibility on older siblings.

Water Watchers need a break, too. Rotate the duty on to another adult as long as children are playing near the water.

BARRIFRS

Florida law requires barriers, such as a fence or cover for home pools, (Fla. Stat. § 515.29); however, don't just assume that barriers are working properly or that they are effectively in place.

BE PREPARED IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

Think about how you would handle an emergency. Be prepared to call 9-1-1 immediately. Remain calm and take charge in an emergency. Administer CPR as soon as possible.

SOCIAL MEDIA AND BEING ONLINE A USEFUL GUIDE FOR KIDS AND ADULTS





Children of all ages use the Internet for many things: doing schoolwork, communicating with friends, social media, playing games and more. That's why it's important to help ensure they make good decisions when going online. Here are some talking points to discuss with children regarding computer security.

- Protecting their personal information. Social Security numbers, account numbers, and passwords are examples of information to keep private.
- Watching out for "free" stuff. Free games, ring tones, or other downloads can hide malware. Tell your kids not to download anything unless they trust the source and they've scanned it with security software.
- Using strong email passwords and protect them. The longer the password, the
 harder it is to crack. Personal information, your login name, common words, or
 adjacent keys on the keyboard are not safe passwords. Kids can protect their
 passwords by not sharing them with anyone, including their friends.

In addition, be sure your family computers are protected by reputable security software and use these basic computer security practices.







HURRICANE SEASON – ARE YOU PREPARED?

Hurricane season runs from June 1st – November 30th. Gather supplies for your family's disaster kit, review your family's plan on evacuation or sheltering at home, survey your home's preparation needs, etc. Sign up for the City of Weston's **CodeRED** system by clicking here to register. **CodeRED** is used only for emergency and life safety purposes.
