Hard work has paid off for two of Weston FC's U12 Competitive Soccer Teams – the Boys' and Girls' teams each won the Danone Nations Cup this year! This was the third time in seven years that the Boys' team won the championship. The Girls' team won the

inaugural All-Girls national tournament that Danone Cup hosted this year. Both teams will be traveling to New York to represent the USA at the Danone Nations Cup World Finals in late September.

Established in 2000, the Danone Nations Cup is the world's largest soccer tournament for players ages 10 – 12.



In 2017, an All-Girls tournament was added. Over 2.5 million children participate in the tournament annually, with just 500 participants advancing to the World Finals.

This month, the teams were excited to be a part of a promotional filming for The Danone Cup that took place at Tequesta Trace Park.

Tournament ambassador, Abby Wambach, spent time with the players interacting in a training session for the

filming.

The Weston City Commission will honor the teams in September.

- Heartsaver CPR/AED training class is offered monthly.

CPR – cardiopulmonary resuscitation - can make a dramatic difference between life and death when a person's heart stops suddenly due to cardiac arrest.

CPR, with an emphasis on chest compressions, and rapid defibrillation with an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), are the first critical components in the *Chain of Survival*. The chain is then completed with early advance life support care by paramedics and transporting the patient to the hospital for further care.

Every two years, City of Weston staff are offered the opportunity to participate in the Heartsaver CPR AED training facilitated by Melanie Brocato, Life Safety Educator for BSO Weston Fire Rescue. This year, Mayor Stermer joined in on the training.

# NFL SPORTS DAY FOR YMCA





# MAKE A HURRICANE SUPPLY KIT HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

# Be #WestonReady Throughout the Season

**MAKE A "GO BAG".** This is a bag, which once you have it prepared, that all you will need to do is just grab it and get out in the event of an emergency. Find a large, waterproof bag and put the following items in:

- Copies of all important papers, passports, birth certificates, all insurance documents, etc.; if you have the time, put the originals of all papers in a safe deposit box in a bank
- Your camera, with pictures of your entire house taken before the storm and then pictures after you put up the storm shutters (for insurance purposes)
- List of all medications that every family member is currently taking
- As the time draws nears and the weather is getting worse, put your medicines in a zip-top bag and then into your GO bag
- A phone book or print out of phone numbers of friends and family and doctors
- Pet food, pictures of your pets, pet medicines and rabies vaccination papers



- Flashlights and batteries
- A change of clothes
- Cash
- A radio with batteries
- Pen and paper
- Tissues
- Bandages and anti-bacterial hand wash
- Water and non-perishable snacks
- Anything else important to your family's immediate survival and comfort

## **DOING BUSINESS IN WESTON?**

Renew Your Business Tax Receipt by September 30<sup>th</sup>

The City of Weston reminds you that all businesses in Weston are required to have an active Business Tax Receipt (BTR) before engaging in any business in the City of Weston, including home-based businesses. The BTR must be renewed annually.

Business Tax Receipts are due and payable on or before September 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. Renewal invoices were mailed out on July 1<sup>st</sup> to the mailing address that the City has on file. It is the businesses responsibility to notify the City of Weston should there be any changes.

According to Florida State Statute, Chapter 205, Business Tax Receipts that are not renewed by the due date are considered delinquent and subject to a delinquency penalty of 10 percent for the month of October, plus an additional 5 percent penalty for each subsequent month of delinquency until paid. Any individual who engages in any business, occupation, or profession covered by this chapter, who does not pay the required business tax within 150 days after the initial notice of the tax due, and who does not obtain the required receipt is subject to civil actions and penalties, including court costs, reasonable attorneys' fees, additional administrative costs incurred as a result of collection efforts, and a penalty of up to \$250.

#### TIRE SAFETY AND VEHICLE PREPARATION

Tires are your vehicle's first line of defense on the road; yet it is estimated that there are approximately 11,000 tire-related crashes annually. Click here for tips on tire safety.

#### BUCKLE UP – SEATBELT USAGE FOR DRIVERS AND PASSENGERS

All drivers, front seat passengers and passengers under the age of 18, must fasten their safety belts according to Florida law. Every time you get in a vehicle, no matter where you are sitting, buckle up. Learn why it is important to wear your seat belt.

**MOVE OVER** | SHIFT LANES WHEN EMERGENCY VEHICLES ARE ON THE SHOULDER Florida law requires you to **Move Over** a lane — when you can safely do so — for stopped law enforcement, emergency, sanitation, utility service vehicles and tow trucks.

- If you can't move over or when on a two-lane road slow to a speed that is 20 mph less than the posted speed limit.
- Slow down to 5 mph when the posted speed limit is 20 mph or less.

Violating the Move Over law will result in a fine, fees, and points on your driving record. For more information, see section 316.126, Florida Statutes.
