WHAT YOU CAN DO TO STOP THE BREEDING OF MOSQUITOES


With the heavy rains experienced earlier this month, come mosquitoes which thrive in the rainy season. Broward County Mosquito Control is actively working in Weston and City of Weston staff are in touch with them daily. Weston's parks were treated on Friday June 9th and Monday, June 12th; and residential areas were treated nightly the week of June 12th. Treatment by Broward County Mosquito Control

Local municipalities work with Broward County to request community-wide treatment; however, individual requests can also be made to Broward County Mosquito Control.

Reduce Mosquito Breeding Around Your Home or Business

Residents are encouraged to reduce mosquito breeding by:

- **Drain standing water** in pots, plants, buckets, roof gutters, toys, etc. around your yard. Check the area daily to spill out any standing water.
- Cover any open containers, such as garbage cans.
- Flush out water holding plants, such as bromeliads, at least once a week.

Hurricane Preparedness – A Continuing Series

With the arrival of Hurricane Season, the City of Weston reminds residents and businesses to sign up for CodeRED to receive important emergency alerts.

What is CodeRED?

CodeRED is a high-speed telephone communication service for emergency notifications. The system allows the City to send critical communications, to all subscribers or targeted areas, for situations that require immediate action.

Register today!

Registration is simple and takes only a few minutes.



Visit <u>Westonfl.org</u> and click on CodeRed Enrollment (circled above) and follow the prompts to input the required contact information.

Don't have a computer?

Call the Weston Communications Department at 954-385-2000.

How does CodeRED work?

CodeRED delivers a recorded message from the City of Weston describing the emergency situation and any instructions for immediate or future action. The number will display on Caller ID as **866-419-5000.** To hear the last message delivered, simply dial the number back. If you opt-in for text message or email alerts, those will also be sent simultaneously.

Already enrolled? Be sure to verify your registration. Make it part of your annual hurricane preparedness plan to log on to **CodeRED** to update phone numbers, opt in to receive text message or email alerts.

<u>PRIVACY</u>: Your contact information remains private and is only used for critical communications.

THIS SYSTEM WILL ONLY BE USED FOR EMERGENCY AND LIFE SAFETY PURPOSES.

The CodeRED system is used to send out alerts such as boil water alerts, extended utility outages, missing person, fires, floods, hostage situation, chemical spill or gas leak, hurricane response and cleanup and other incidents where rapid and accurate notification is essential.

Rainout Line

Rainout Line is a field status notification system used by the City of Weston Parks and Recreation Department to notify the public of park and field closures. This service is easy to use and offers a variety of ways to receive alerts about field closures. When a decision is made, Rainout Line allows you to receive cancellation information instantly by text message or Email, or several other methods using your phone or computer access.

RainoutLine Notification Options


WESTON FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

Know What to Expect in Your Mailbox Every Day

SOMETHING MISSING?

If you receive an image of a letter, but not the physical piece itself, *Informed Delivery* makes it easy to report that missing mailpiece to the Postal Service. The image can help speed up the process of finding what's missing.

A TOOL TO PREVENT IDENTITY THEFT

If you are missing an important piece of mail— a credit card bill. tax document or financial statement — you can start working to find out what happened. With identity the auicker theft, discover a problem, the faster you can manage the damage.

What is Informed Delivery?

The United States Postal Service (USPS) offers this free notification service that gives eligible residential consumers the ability to see a preview of their letter mail before it arrives daily. Notifications are sent by email or viewed online with a grayscale image of the outside of the letter-sized mail that is scheduled to be delivered on that day.

Notifications are only sent on days when there is regular mail delivery.



Why Use Informed Delivery?

Participating consumers have access to their household's mail whenever, wherever they are – even as they travel. In some instances, users will have the ability to interact with digital content associated with the mailpiece images. Have roommates? This service allows the entire household to view the mail daily, not just the individual that retrieves the mail from the mailbox.
