## TEQUESTA TRACE PARK FIELD CONVERSION UPDATE

Two natural grass football/soccer fields were converted to multi-purpose artificial turf fields.



There are numerous benefits to artificial turf, particularly for active fields. Artificial turf can be played on during wet conditions; they require far less maintenance than grass; they will not develop holes and divots; and they increase capacity.



## FIELDS COMPLETED!

The transformation of two grass fields within Tequesta Trace Park to artificial turf is complete. The artificial surface will allow for year-round use, not needing to be re-sodded, and can be played on in wet conditions.

The artificial turf has been utilized on several hockey rink conversions in Regional Park which received rave reviews. The Parks and Recreation Department staff

spent approximately 6 years researching the best available products and visiting turf field installations. The selected product, using an <u>organic infill</u>, is of the highest quality and meets all safety, performance and environmental considerations set in place for the best interests of residents and visitors alike.



The fields will be used mainly for football, lacrosse, and rugby as well as use by the Tequesta Trace Middle School sports programs.





## **MEMORIAL DAY**

## City Offices Will be Closed on Monday, May 29th



Memorial Day is a United States federal holiday that is observed on the last Monday of May. Formerly known as Decoration Day, this holiday commemorates U.S. men and women who gave the ultimate sacrifice in service to their country. It began first to honor Union soldiers who died during the American Civil War. After World War I, it was expanded to include those who died in any war or military action.

A national moment of remembrance takes place annually at 3:00 p.m.

It is a tradition to fly the U.S. flag at half-staff from dawn until noon at many ceremonies and government buildings. The half-staff position pays respect to the more than one million men and women who gave their lives in service of their country. At noon, their memory is raised by the living, who resolve not to let their sacrifice be in vain, but to rise up in their stead and continue the fight for liberty and justice for all.

Please take time to remember those who gave the ultimate sacrifice while serving our country.
