# WESTON UNIVERSITY PROGRAM BACK IN SESSION

#### Day One Focuses on Local Government Operations

The City of Weston kicked off the sixteenth year of the Weston University program on Wednesday, October 25<sup>th</sup> by hosting the eighteen high school students that comprise the program's Class of 2018. The program exposes students to local government, giving them first-hand insight of the work that goes into running a city. Students meet once monthly from October through April. The first program day included an overview by City Manager, John R. Flint; a session with Mayor Daniel Stermer and ethics and legal perspectives by City Attorney Jamie Alan Cole.

Students are selected by their respective schools and represent Cypress Bay High School, Western High School and Sagemont Upper School.



# ARTIFICIAL TURF SOCCER FIELDS REGIONAL PARK SOCCER FIELDS #1 & #2



Teguesta Trace Park Artificial Turf Fields

After the recent success of the installation of artificial turf fields with organic infill at Tequesta Trace Park, soccer fields #1 and #2 at Weston Regional Park are receiving the same gold star treatment.

There are numerous benefits to artificial turf, particularly for active fields. Artificial turf can be

played on during wet conditions; they require far less maintenance than grass; they will not develop holes and divots; and they increase capacity. Weston's soccer fields see a huge demand which causes great wear and tear on the natural grass fields, requiring down time to allow the fields to recover, which requires weeks of no use when fields are re-sodded each year.

The project is anticipated to be completed in late January/early February 2018.


