WHO NEEDS A BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT?

Every business in Weston must have a Business Tax Receipt to engage in business within the City, including home-based businesses. The purpose of the law enacted by the Florida Legislature is to prevent fraud so that businesses are properly licensed and have met all necessary requirements to operate.

HOW TO OBTAIN A BUSINESS TAX RECEIPT (BTR)

STEP ONE Obtain a Certificate of Use

In accordance with City Code, a City of Weston Certificate of Use, issued by the City's Building Code Services Department, is required prior to applying for a Business Tax Receipt, unless the type of business does not require a certificate of use.

STEP TWO Submit a Business Tax Receipt Application Download your BTR Application or pick up an application at City Hall.

STEP THREE Post Payment

WHERE DO I FILE THE BTR APPLICATION?

Completed BTR applications, including required documentation copies and applicable fee are accepted and processed at Weston City Hall.

The following documents are required upon filing your Business Tax Receipt application:

- Copy of Certificate of Use (CU)
- Fictitious Name Registration
- Federal Employer Identification
- Payment

WESTON'S BULK TRASH PICKUP SCHEDULE July 2018

Out with the old, in with the new! Clean out your garage, closets, and storage sheds in time for this month's **FREE** Bulk Pickup, which occurs quarterly throughout the year. Pickup takes place on your *regularly scheduled garbage collection day*.

July 2018:

Single Family Homes and Multi-Family Units with curbside collection

On the day of your regularly scheduled garbage collection: Wednesday, July 18th; Thursday, July 19th, or Friday, July 20th

Multi-family units with dumpsters Saturday, July 21st

NEXT BULK PICKUP: October 17th – 20th

Bulk items include but are not limited to:

- Furniture, mattresses, carpets and other large household items.
- Large and small appliances, such as dishwashers, laundry machines and stoves.
- Refrigerators or air conditioners must have Freon removed by a certified dealer.
- Mirrors, glass, glass top tables, windowpanes, and plate glass items should be safely placed in a rigid container.



NOT COLLECTED: Bulk items DO NOT include contractor-generated material, or vegetative waste (landscape materials) or household hazardous waste.



THINK BEFORE YOU TRASH - CONSIDER DONATING ITEMS:

Help those in need, keep items out of the waste stream, **and** get a tax deduction. Several national organizations will even pick up directly from your residence.

FIRE SAFETY TIPS FOR YOUR HOME

Plan Ahead to Keep Your Family Safe

When it comes to fire emergencies at your home, it is important to be as well prepared for the situation as possible. These simple tips can help keep you and your family safe by preventing a fire in your home or knowing how to handle the situation if a fire does break out:

Make a home fire escape plan

Communicate with your family regarding your home's exits and escape routes. Set a standard procedure to follow in case of a fire and practice that routine. Practice makes perfect!

Dryers and washing machine fires

Be sure to always clean the lint filter before running each dryer load. Inspect the exterior vent pipe to make sure it is clear of lint debris. Never overload your dryer.

Burn Awareness

Prevent serious burn injuries by educating children about things to avoid in the home and reviewing basic fire safety tips in case a fire breaks out. Have a fire extinguisher that is in good working order available and everyone should know where it is located and how to operate it.

Propane Safety

Summer barbeques can go up in flames if you are using a gas grill and you don't follow the manufacturer's instructions for the propane tanks. Do not store or use propane gas inside the home, and make sure to have the equipment inspected periodically by a professional for possible leaks or malfunctions.



Medical Oxygen

Keep oxygen cylinders at least five feet from a heat source, open flames or electrical devices.

QUARTERLY RESIDENTIAL BULK TRASH PICKUP

The Quarterly Residential Bulk Trash Pickup will occur in JULY on your regularly scheduled garbage collection day as follows.

Single Family & Multi-family with curbside collection:

Wednesday, July 18, Thursday, July 19 OR Friday, July 20

Multi-Family with dumpsters ("Containerized Service"): Saturday, July 21

FREE Bulk Pickup will take place on your regularly scheduled garbage collection day and all items should be curbside by 7 a.m.

Bulk items include but are not limited to:

- Furniture, mattresses, carpets and other large household items.
- Large and small appliances, such as dishwashers, laundry machines and stoves.
- Refrigerators or air conditioners must have Freon removed by a certified dealer.
- Mirrors, glass, glass top tables, windowpanes, and plate glass items should be safely placed in a rigid container to facilitate safe collection.
- Customer-generated vegetative debris (tree branches must be 6" in diameter or less).




SAFE SELLING TRANSACTION ZONE A LOCATION FOR ONLINE BUYERS/SELLERS
