DO YOU HAVE A FAMILY PLAN?

Hurricane Preparedness - A Continuing Series

A family emergency & communication plan is an important part of preparations for the hurricane season. Here is a step-by-step list. The key is to START NOW – well in advance of a storm threatening our area.



STEP 1 Hold a family meeting and create a communication plan

Make a plan to secure your home and assist family members who need assistance with shutters, removing patio furniture and other items. Assign tasks to each family member so everyone knows their responsibilities. Make an Emergency Communication Plan, so that all family members know where to go and who to contact should you become separated.

STEP 2 Discuss shelter options

Determine where you will go if a storm threatens our area. General Population Shelters provide only basic needs. A shelter should be your choice of last resort.

• STEP 3 Ensure your assets are protected

Inventory (and photograph) your home possessions, review insurance policies to ensure for adequate coverage. Keep important records in a water-proof and fire-proof container.

• STEP 4 Assess your home for vulnerable areas

Evaluate your roof, windows, garage door, landscaping, etc. and determine what actions can be taken now to help secure your home prior to a storm threatening our area.

• STEP 5 Make a plan to protect your vehicles

Decide where you will store your vehicle, boat or recreational vehicles.

STEP 6 Secure your home

Decide what actions you will need to take to protect your home and property (shutters, generator, trim trees) once a storm watch is issued.

STEP 7 Determine if anyone in your home needs special assistance

Discuss whether anyone in your home is elderly or has special medical needs and, if so, register with Broward County to be on the Special Needs or Vulnerable Population registries.

• STEP 8 Make a plan for your pet

Determine how you will address your pet's needs and make a plan for your pet in case you have to evacuate. Be sure to plan for large animals such as horses.

• STEP 9 Gather your supplies

Determine your family's food, water and medical needs and assemble your family's <u>Disaster Survival</u>
<u>Kit.</u> Visit <u>Westonfl.org/Hurricane</u> for a list of recommended items.

STEP 10 Notify others of your plan

Let family or friends know what your hurricane plan is so they can check on you in the aftermath of the storm.

RainoutLine is a field status notification system used by the City of Weston Parks and Recreation Department to notify the public of park and field closures. This service is easy to use and offers a variety of ways to receive alerts about field closures. When a decision is made, RainoutLine allows you to receive cancellation information instantly by text message or Email, or several other methods using your phone or computer access.

WHAT YOU CAN DO TO STOP THE BREEDING OF MOSQUITOES

With the heavy rains experienced earlier this month, come mosquitoes which thrive in the rainy season. Broward County Mosquito Control is actively working in Weston and City of Weston staff are in touch with them daily.



Treatment by Broward County Mosquito Control

Local municipalities work with Broward County to request community-wide treatment; however, individual requests can also be made to Broward County Mosquito Control.

There are three ways to request service:

Reduce Mosquito Breeding Around Your Home or Business

Residents are encouraged to reduce mosquito breeding by:

- **Drain standing water** in pots, plants, buckets, roof gutters, toys, etc. around your yard. Check the area daily to spill out any standing water.
- Cover any open containers, such as garbage cans.
- Flush out water holding plants, such as bromeliads, at least once a week.

QUARTERLY RESIDENTIAL BULK TRASH PICKUP

The Quarterly Residential Bulk Trash Pickup will occur in JULY on your regularly scheduled garbage collection day as follows.

Single Family & Multi-family with curbside collection:

Wednesday, July 18, Thursday, July 19 OR Friday, July 20

Multi-Family with dumpsters ("Containerized Service"): Saturday, July 21

FREE Bulk Pickup will take place on your regularly scheduled garbage collection day and all items should be curbside by 7 a.m.

Bulk items include but are not limited to:

- Furniture, mattresses, carpets and other large household items.
- Large and small appliances, such as dishwashers, laundry machines and stoves.
- Refrigerators or air conditioners must have Freon removed by a certified dealer.
- Mirrors, glass, glass top tables, windowpanes, and plate glass items should be safely placed in a rigid container to facilitate safe collection.
- Customer-generated vegetative debris (tree branches must be 6" in diameter or less).
