

## **COUNTRY ISLES**Street Lighting Upgrades

The Country Isles neighborhood in Weston, the oldest in the City, is receiving an upgrade of street light poles and fixtures to equal the standard City of Weston white metal street light pole, but at the lower height of twentyfive feet.

The overall lighting will be improved and more energy efficient with the use of modern LED light fixtures as the existing light fixtures are obsolete.

This capital improvement project is taking place on two City owned roadways: Three Village Road and Country Isles Road/Windmill Ranch Road.

The project, started in April, is expected to be completed in September 2018, dependent upon weather.

#### **Hurricane Preparedness – A Continuing Series**

With the arrival of Hurricane Season, the City of Weston reminds residents and businesses to sign up for CodeRED to receive important emergency alerts.

#### What is CodeRED?

**CodeRED** is a high-speed telephone communication service for emergency notifications. The system allows the City to send critical communications, to all subscribers or targeted areas, for situations that require immediate action.

#### **Register today!**

Registration is simple and takes only a few minutes.



Visit <u>WestonFL.org</u> and click on CodeRed Enrollment (circled above) and follow the prompts to input the required contact information.

#### Don't have a computer?

Call the Weston Communications Department at 954-385-2000.

#### How does CodeRED work?

CodeRED delivers a recorded message from the City of Weston describing the emergency situation and any instructions for immediate or future action. The number will display on Caller ID as **866-419-5000.** To hear the last message delivered, simply dial the number back. If you opt-in for text message or email alerts, those will also be sent simultaneously.

**Already enrolled?** Be sure to verify your registration. Make it part of your annual hurricane preparedness plan to log on to **CodeRED** to update phone numbers and opt in to receive text message or email alerts.

**PRIVACY:** Your contact information remains private and is only used for critical communications.

### THIS SYSTEM WILL ONLY BE USED FOR EMERGENCY AND LIFE SAFETY PURPOSES.

The CodeRED system is used to send out alerts such as boil water alerts, missing person, fires, floods, hostage situation, chemical spill or gas leak, hurricane response and cleanup and other incidents where rapid and accurate notification is essential.



#### How to Access DMV Services

Renewing your driver's license, changing your name or address, or getting a new license for those that took the written test online or at a third-party administrator, (such as driver's education or online), have no fear. You've got options!

#### Make an Appointment at a DHSMV Service Center

If you are required to apply in person, vou can visit a local DMV office; appointments however, are highly recommended. Click here to view a list of DMV Service Centers in Broward and to make an appointment online.

#### Visit a Mobile Office Florida Licensing On Wheels (FLOW)

Mobile offices offer a convenient method to renew a driver license, obtain a replacement driver license, change a name or address on a driver license, get an identification card, renew a vehicle registration, etc. If you have time to wait for a convenient location, then this is a great option as there is usually minimal wait time at these locations. No written or driving tests are given from mobile offices.



If your license is REAL ID compliant (look for the gold star on the license) then you allowed а one-time online convenience renewal. You can also update the address on your license or replace a lost or stolen ID via this online process. Visit GoRenew.com to see if you are eligible.

#### LIVING WITH ALLIGATORS

#### SAFETY TIPS TO KEEP YOU OUT OF HARMS WAY



It is possible that you may see an alligator in or near the water bodies throughout South Florida. Grates are in place on all four of Weston's main drainage canals that feed into the Everglades to inhibit the movement of large alligators to the interior lake system; however, alligators also travel over land. June is still alligator mating season and they tend to become more visible as they travel seeking a mate. Urbanization around traditional alligator habitats has also caused increased contact between alligators and people. Their adaptability has resulted in alligators being found in unlikely places: underneath cars in

driveways, in drainage ditches, swimming pools and on golf courses.

If you see an alligator, stay calm. They generally have no intentions of bothering you. Feeding, harassing, or killing alligators violate State law, so just leave them alone. Review safety tips with your children and teens that may be out and about this summer. And remember – the water bodies in Weston are for drainage, not for recreational purposes.

Alligators depend on the wetlands, and the wetlands environment depends on them as they help control the population of rodents and other animals that might overtax the marshland vegetation.

#### **Reporting Nuisance Alligators**

If an alligator appears threatening, comes close to your home, or becomes a risk for humans or pets, contact the **Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission** (FWC) at **866-392-4286.** Only alligators determined to be a nuisance can be removed and the FWC will make



that determination and contact a licensed trapper. The City of Weston is not permitted to handle an alligator for any reason.


