DAYLIGHT SAVING Things to Remember!

Daylight Saving Time (DST) will begin on **Sunday, March 11**th at 2:00 AM EST and will remain in effect until we "fall back" at 2:00 AM EST on Sunday, November 4th.



Ready to Spring Forward this Sunday?

On March 11th, the clocks are turned forward one hour to 3:00 AM. Yes, you will lose one hour of sleep on that day!

Daylight Saving Time also means it's time for a seasonal safety check! As you circle the house, setting any manual clocks ahead, make time for this short safety checklist.

Change the Clocks, Change the Batteries.

Smoke and carbon monoxide detectors detectors save lives...if they're powered on by a fresh battery. Safety experts recommend replacing smoke and carbon monoxide detector batteries twice annually, so celebrate Time Change Sunday with fresh batteries all around.

Replace the Light Bulbs.

Chances are, you'll have stepladders out to reach smoke detectors and clocks, so double up on safety (and energy savings) by checking light bulbs and light fixtures. Consider replacing conventional bulbs with energy-efficient LED bulbs.

Check the First-Aid Kit.

Summer is coming ... along with bumps, scrapes and stings. Review this <u>checklist for Family Emergency Kit</u> items recommended by the Centers for Disease Control that you should have on hand. Replace any missing or expired items.

Review your Family Emergency Plan.

If an emergency strikes, will your family know what to do?

Review your family's emergency plan or create one for the first time. Update phone numbers, addresses and contact information, and post an emergency information page in a location where everyone has access.

16th Annual Broward Water Matters Day Saturday, March 10, 2018 • 9 AM • 3 PM Water Matters...and Conservation Pays

"Water Matters...and Conservation Pays" is the theme of the 16th Annual Broward Water Matters Day event to be celebrated on Saturday, March 10th from 9:00am – 3:00pm at Tree Tops Park in Davie.

Water Matters Day is Broward's signature water conservation event where residents can learn about our valuable local and regional water resources, how water is managed, and how water managers are planning to meet our future water needs. Residents will receive tips on water conservation, find out about rebates and incentives for upgrading to water-conserving devices, learn how to create "Florida-friendly" and drought tolerant landscapes, and get lots of eco-friendly tips.

Water Matters Day exhibits show how to save and protect water through landscape best management practices and through indoor conservation. They also help explain local water management, Everglades restoration, and how our canals connect the County's urban and natural systems.

Workshops with landscaping gardening experts give attendees insight into how to make their yards less water dependent and more inviting to native wildlife. The workshops provide in-depth information and an important opportunity for learning in small groups where guestions can be answered personally. A popular session each year is how to create NatureScape. Experts explain the importance of environmentally-friendly landscaping, with tips on plant selection and placement, proper fertilizer and pesticide use, and more.

The best part is that while Water Matters Day is about education, it's also about fun. The event is packed with workshops, giveaways, children's activities, and entertainment. While parents are learning about choosing the right plants for their yards, children can have their face painted or participate in various activities such as planting flowers to take home.






