



CITY OF WESTON NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF WATER SUPPLY PLANNING COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS

The City Commission of the City of Weston proposes to adopt the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CITY'S WATER SUPPLY FACILITIES WORK PLAN AND APPLICABLE ELEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN RELATING TO WATER SUPPLY PLANNING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Commission, in its capacity as the Local Planning Agency, will hold a **Public Hearing on Monday, March 1, 2021 at 7:00 P.M.**, or as soon thereafter as possible, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider and make recommendations to the City Commission, in its capacity as the governing body of the City, regarding the Ordinance described above.

PLEASE NOTE: the City Commission will hold a **Public Hearing and First Reading of the Ordinance on Monday, March 1, 2021**, immediately following the hearing of the Local Planning Agency, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The City Commission may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time certain without further notice provided the date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinance in its entirety may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk during regular working hours.

Persons wishing to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such hearing will need a record of the proceedings and for such purpose may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.

All City Commission Meetings will be conducted virtually (online) until the Local State of Emergency due to COVID-19 is lifted.

At specific moments during the meeting, you will be able to “raise hand” to notify the meeting Host that you wish to speak either during ‘Audience Comments’ or on any Agenda Item. The meeting Host will individually unmute each attendee in the queue to speak. Each speaker will be allowed up to 3 minutes. Please note, public attendees will only have audio capabilities during the meeting. Video streaming of individuals is reserved for the City Commission and Staff.
