WHEREAS, Third, it is sound and prudent practice to amend the budget to reflect revised estimates based upon actual experience year to date as well as any changes in priorities set by the City Commission and changes in circumstances which impact operations; and

WHEREAS, Fourth, staff recommends amending the budget, as a result of the creation of a Debt Service Fund and moving all of the debt service budget and actual revenues, expenditures, and fund balances lines from the Capital Projects Fund to the Debt Service Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Weston, Florida:

Section 1: The above recital is true and correct and incorporated herein.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Fiscal Year 2021 Budget for the City of Weston is hereby amended and restated to revise the budget for the creation of a Debt Service Fund and moving all of the debt service budget and actual revenues, expenditures, and fund balances lines from the Capital Projects Fund to the Debt Service Fund. A full and complete copy of the amendments is hereby attached as "Exhibit A" and is incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

<u>Section 3</u>: The appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
