Every 34 seconds, one child under age 13 is involved in a crash.
Don't let your child be a victim.



Buckle up!
Every ride. Every time.

Choose the right **car seat** for the child's age, weight, and height.

Drive like your **life is on the line.**

All **children under 13** should ride **buckled** in the **back seat.**

A **hot car** can be **deadly** — look before you lock.

Don't text and drive.

Always **walk around** the vehicle before **backing up.**

Get "**CarFit.**" Properly adjusted vehicles can increase the driver's and passenger's safety.

Keep valuables out of sight or in the trunk.

Buckle up, slow down, don't drive impaired.
Park in busy, well-lit areas.

Always lock the doors, even outside the house or in the garage.
