### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening and repaving the road to provide bicycle lanes on Weston Road
- Adding green colored markings in bike lanes to increase driver awareness at conflict points
- Striping and signing of the existing roadway
- Pedestrian signal upgrades
- Replacement of deficient Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pedestrian ramps

### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- All work will be done in phases to reduce the impact of construction to the community
- All lane closures will occur during non-peak hours
- No full roadway closures will occur
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times during construction

- Anticipated Completion: **Spring 2023**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$3 Million**

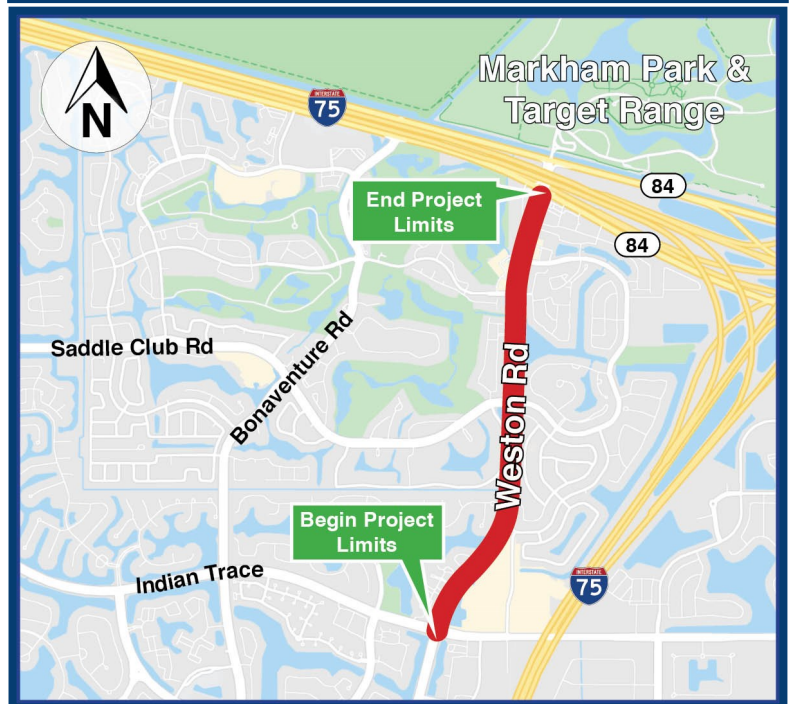
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### FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION MISSION STATEMENT
