To All Bidders:

Bidders for the above referenced Bid shall take note of the following changes, additions, deletions, clarifications, etc., to the bid documents, which shall become a part of and have precedence over anything shown or described otherwise.

A. CHANGES IN THE BID DOCUMENTS

1. Page 00300-4 "ARTICLE 7.0 BID AMOUNTS", has been revised to delete Line Item No. 8 for Restoration. Please see attached "REVISED ARTICLE 7.0 BID AMOUNTS", to be completed and submitted as part of the bid submittal.

B. CLARIFICATIONS

None.

C. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

1. Q: The bid title notes "refurbishment", is the City's expectation to completely remove current marking and replace with new marking and not re-use any of the current markings?

A: City staff will identify limits for complete restoration (remove and replace). All other areas will be re-topped.

2. Q: Is there any "green" currently installed?

A: No, all green marking proposed under this project is new.

3. On Bid Sheet Item #8 - Restoration – What restorations are anticipated or needed?

A: The line restoration line item has been deleted. See attached "REVISED ARTICLE 7.0 BID AMOUNTS".

4. Q: County plan is showing 90 mils or 125 mils thermos paint thickness, what will be the thickness of the thermoplastic?

A: Minimum 90 mils.

5. Does City like to grind all existing markings?

A: City staff will identify limits for grinding. Grinding not to exceed 25,000 LF.

6. Q: What is the required MOT?

A: Most of the MOT is moving and may only require a crash truck and early warning signs except on intersections where lane closures or channelization may be need. All MOT shall be per FDOT Standard Index and reviewed and approved by the City. Some locations are in school zone areas and installation schedule shall accommodate school drop off and pick up times.

7. Q: Looking at some of the street pictures provided, please advise if the intent is to follow Broward County's specs for the panels with the green background, 20X4 bike lane with arrow, 4X7 (bicycle or arrow), and 4X10 (shared lane).

A: Yes. All pavement markings including the green markings shall conform to Broward County Pavement Making details, included with the project plans.

8. Q: Is this a 60-day project?

A: 45 days from NTP for substantial completion and 60 days from NTP for final completion.

9. Q: Would the CITY consider accepting a qualifier to meet the minimum five (5) year requirement?

A: Bidders may submit a bid, if interested, and include any supporting documentation available. The information received will be presented to the Selection Committee for their consideration.

10. Q: Will the City consider performing a second pre-bid meeting or change it from "Mandatory" to "Non-mandatory"?

A: The City does not intend to hold a second mandatory pre-bid conference. Bidders that did not attend the mandatory pre-bid may submit a bid, if interested. The information received will be presented to the Selection Committee for their consideration.
