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About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the “livability” of Weston. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents’ opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 303 residents of the City of Weston collected from July 12, 2022 to August 30, 2022. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 6% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2022 survey was 11%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Weston.

How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the “percent positive.” Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer “don’t know.” The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab “Complete data.” However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC’s database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Weston’s results are noted as being “higher” than the benchmark, “lower” than the benchmark, or “similar” to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Weston residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as “higher” or “lower” than the benchmark means that Weston’s average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was “much higher” or “much lower,” then Weston’s average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your City’s 2022 ratings compare to other communities’ ratings from the past five years.



Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the City of Weston were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Weston was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the City of Weston households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the City of Weston boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the “person whose birthday has most recently passed” to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on July 12, 2022 and the survey remained open for seven weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

The survey was available in English and Spanish. All mailings contained paragraphs in both languages instructing participants on how to complete the survey in their preferred language.

About 1% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,759 households that received the invitations to participate, 303 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 11%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR’s response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a “level of confidence” and accompanying “confidence interval” (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents’ opinions are relied on to estimate all residents’ opinions. The margin of error for the City of Weston survey is no greater than plus or minus six percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (303 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected “probability sample” of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Weston. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it asked a question to confirm the respondent is a Weston resident and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on August 16, 2022. The survey remained open for two weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a “key and verify” method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the City of Weston. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

NRC aligns demographic labels with those used by the U.S. Census for reporting purposes, when possible. Some categories (e.g., age, race/Hispanic origin, housing type, and length of residency) are combined into smaller subgroups.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python, and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the “percent positive.” The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating “yes” or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer “don’t know.” The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab “Complete data”. However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Highlights

Weston residents experience an overwhelmingly high quality of life.

Residents value and emphasize the high quality of life in Weston. Virtually every respondent positively rated the city as a place to live as well as the overall quality of life in the community. Similarly, almost all residents indicated they planned to remain in the city for the next five years (98%) and were either very or somewhat likely to recommend living in Weston to others (94%). The overall image and reputation of the city among its residents was also overwhelmingly positive (97%). Ratings for all survey items pertaining to Weston's quality of life were higher or much higher than national benchmarks.

Residents are pleased with their local government, and the City's COVID-19 response is rated favorably.

When asked questions relating to Weston's government and its performance, about 8 out of 10 residents gave the City positive marks. Most survey items relating to governance received higher or much higher scores compared to national benchmarks. The overall customer service provided by Weston employees performed the best among respondents, with at least 9 in 10 rating it as excellent or good. Other items including treating residents with respect, being honest, generally acting in the best interest of the community and treating all residents fairly received positive ratings from at least 8 out of 10 residents.

In a survey question unique to Weston, residents were asked which sources they use for obtaining information about Weston's government and its activities, events and services. Nearly all respondents reported using the city website (www.westonfl.org) to stay informed, while 8 out of 10 respondents mentioned local media outlets (i.e., newspapers, radio, local television stations) on par with the city social media accounts (i.e., Facebook, Twitter or Instagram). Word-of-mouth and the city e-newsletter, *Newsday Tuesday*, were the next most popular sources of information at 75%.

Another question unique to Weston asked residents to rate the city's response to COVID-19. About 8 out of 10 respondents rated the overall government response as excellent or very good. In addition, 9 of 10 respondents positively rated the City generally acting in the best interest of the community, while 8 of 10 positively rated the job the City did informing residents about COVID-19 related issues as well as being open and transparent to the public...

Inclusivity is strong but engagement and participation may be areas of opportunity.

Inclusivity ratings are strong in Weston. Nine out of 10 respondents rated positively the job the community does respecting residents from different backgrounds, while at least 8 in 10 viewed favorably the job the City does making all residents feel welcome (86%) and attracting people from different backgrounds (85%). Engagement ratings were mostly positive but not so strong, offering Weston a potential area of improvement: the opportunities to participate in social events and activities were rated positively by 75% of respondents while the neighborliness of residents scored 73%. Opportunities to participate in community matters and to volunteer scored below 70%. Relatedly, residents' civic participation ratings (as voting, contacting the City, volunteering time to a group, watching public meetings and/or campaigning for a local issue or candidate) were among the few items where the City ranked below the national benchmarks.

Safety is a community strength and remains a priority for residents.

Safety is a key issue for Weston residents as it's considered not only the most important facet of liability for Weston but also the most important strategic planning area to the overall quality of life. In this regard, residents declared feeling safe in the Weston community and gave positive reviews to public safety services. Roughly 95% of community members rated the overall feeling of safety in the city as excellent or good. Most residents reported feeling either very or somewhat safe in their neighborhoods during the day (98%) and in Weston commercial area during the day (96%). At least 9 in 10 residents felt safe from both property crime and violent crime, and about 8 in 10 said the same for natural disasters. All items in this area were above or on par with the national benchmarks.

The City's safety services were also highly assessed by Weston residents, with roughly 9 in 10 respondents favorably rating ambulance or emergency medical services, fire services, emergency preparedness, police services, crime prevention, animal control and fire prevention and education.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation. The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).

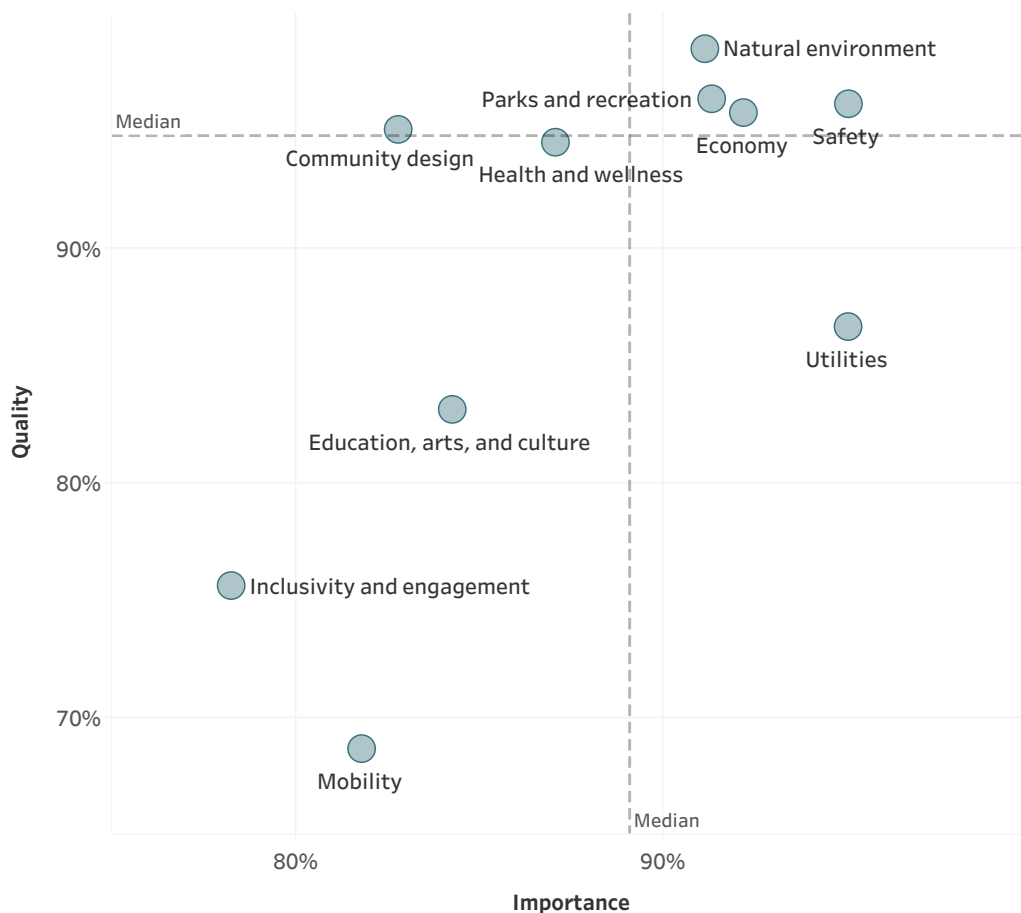
Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide City staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.

Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 95% or more of respondents were considered of “higher quality” and those with ratings lower than 95% were considered to be of “lower quality.” Services were classified as “more important” if they were rated as essential or very important by 89% or more of respondents. Services were rated as “less important” if they received a rating of less than 89%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

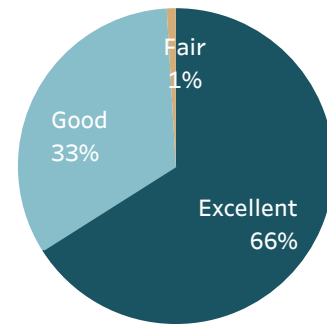
The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.



Quality of life

Measuring community livability starts with assessing the quality of life of those who live there, and ensuring that the community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.

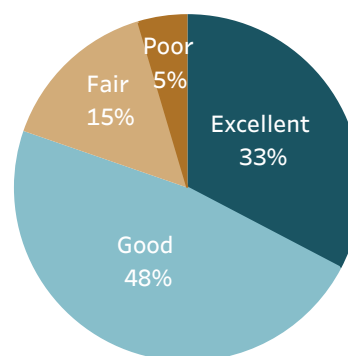

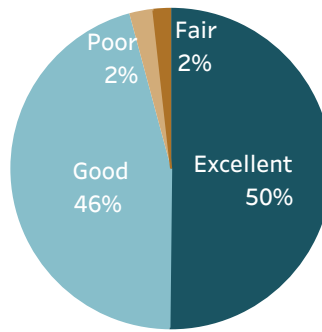

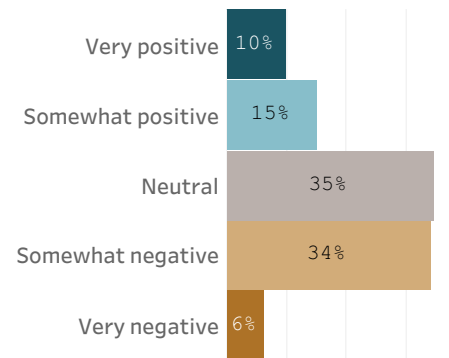

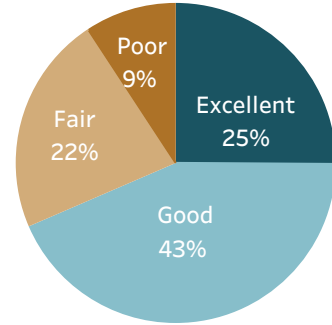

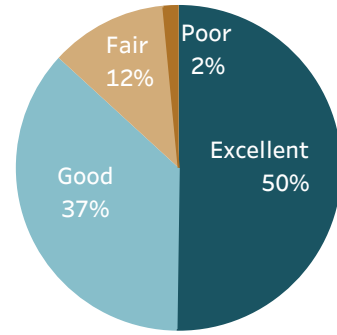

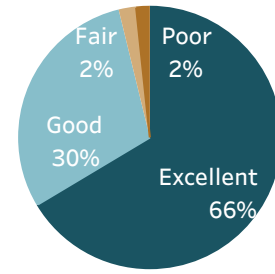

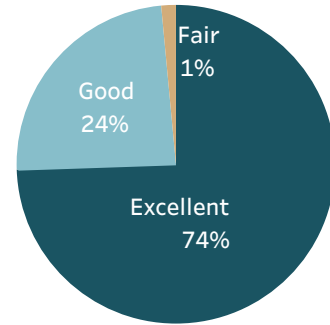

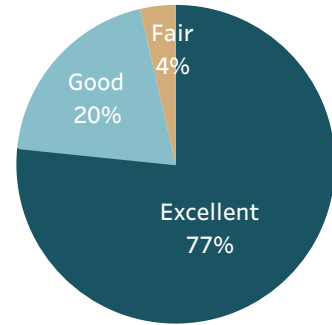

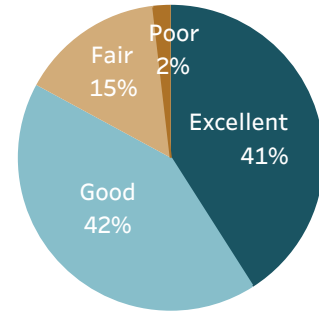

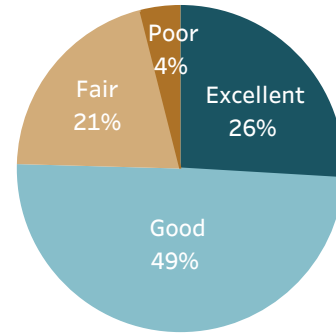

Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCST™), the City of Weston conducted a survey of 303 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from July 12, 2022 to August 30, 2022. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents’ opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the City of Weston. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it asked a question to confirm that the respondent is a Weston resident and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all city residents and became available on August 16, 2022. The survey remained open for two weeks and there were 89 responses.





























The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, and housing tenure. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.]




