

CITY OF WESTON NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Commission of the City of Weston proposes to adopt the following Ordinances:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, CREATING NEW SECTIONS 20.01-20.30, CODIFYING THE CITY COMMISSION PROCEDURES, AND REVISING AND RENUMBERING SECTION 20.01, "CITY COMMISSION; REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL EXPENSES;" AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

And

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, TO ESTABLISH SECTION 124.80(F), "ADMINISTRATIVE VARIANCE," TO CREATE A PROCESS FOR DEVIATIONS FROM CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR SINGLE-FAMILY ZONED PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A Public Hearing on the Ordinances will be held by the City Commission **Monday, April 17, 2023, and a Second and Final Hearing will be held Monday, May 1, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The City Commission may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time certain without further notice provided the date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinances in their entirety may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk during regular working hours.

Pursuant to State Law, the Ordinance of the City of Weston, Florida, amending the Code of Ordinances of the City, to establish Section 124.80(F), "Administrative Variance," to create a process for deviations from certain requirements for single-family zoned property; and providing for an effective date is to be reviewed by the Local Planning Agency and considered by the City Commission. As permitted by Section 163.3174 of the Florida Statutes, the City Commission also serves as the Local Planning Agency; therefore, the City Commission, both in our capacity as Local Planning Agency and as the governing body of the City will hear the item on Monday, April 17, 2023, at 7:00 p.m.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.
