Bidders for the above referenced Bid shall take note of the following changes, additions, deletions, clarifications, etc., to the bid documents, which shall become a part of and have precedence over anything shown or described otherwise.

### A. CHANGES IN THE BID DOCUMENTS

1. Sheet 2 of project plans, General Notes, Section F, Root Guard or Barrier, is hereby deleted.

### F. Foot Guard or Barrier

1. Root barrier material shall be the Bio Barrier root guard and shall be twenty four (24) inches wide and installed per manufacturer's instructions. The root pruning shall be performed by a City registered arborist.

### **B. CLARIFICATIONS**

None.

## C. QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

- Q: Is there root pruning and form inspections required before pouring the concrete?
   A: Yes, the root pruning is required. See Sheet 3, General Notes Section N. Form inspections are required prior to concrete pour.
- 2. Q: Will there be root barriers installed where the roots lift the concrete?
  - A: No. See Section "A" above.
- 3. Q: Will there be any concrete cylinder or compaction density testing required?
  - A: No. Copies of delivery tickets are required reflecting the specified mix.
- 4. Q: Where exactly will the root pruning be required?
  - A: As needed. Staff will identify locations and will be limited to areas where concrete work is proposed (sidewalk and curb ramps replacement).

- 5. Q: Would the existing ADA ramps require demolition and replacing?
  - A: Yes, see project plans for details.
- 6. Q: Is the detectable warning area a brick paver and not a cast in place?
  - A: Yes, see project plans for details.
- 7. Q: Is the Bidder required to pay permit fees or are they waived by the CITY?
  - A: Permits are required but the fees are waived.
- 8. Q: Can the CONTRACTOR work on all three areas simultaneously or will it need to be one area at a time?
  - A: One area at a time.
- 10: Q: In regard to the milling, would we have to pave back whatever is milled under one shift or can we mill ahead of time and then come in and pave?
  - A: Roadway sections milled shall be paved within 48 hours.
- 11. Q: Will this be for day or night work?
  - A: Day work, times are listed in the plans.
- 12. Q: Will there be any staging areas that can be used by the CONTRACTOR?
  - A: The CITY does not own any land in the area, other than the right-of-way.
- 13. Q: Is the CITY looking to do the concrete work first and then the milling and resurfacing or both simultaneously?
  - A: It is up to the CONTRACTOR.
- 14. Q: When will the job start?
  - A: Approximately in October.
