## CITY OF WESTON NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Commission of the City of Weston proposes to adopt the following Ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, FLORIDA, REZONING A PORTION OF THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 357 RACQUET CLUB ROAD, CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 6.17 ACRES, FROM LOW RISE MULTI FAMILY (MF2) AND COMMERCIAL (C-1) ZONING DISTRICTS TO MID RISE MULTI FAMILY (MF3) AND COMMERCIAL (C-1) ZONING DISTRICTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A Public Hearing on the Ordinance will be held by the City Commission Tuesday, January 16, 2024, and a Second and Final Hearing will be held Monday, February 20, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as possible, at Weston City Hall, 17200 Royal Palm Boulevard, Weston, Florida. The City Commission may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time certain without further notice provided the date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinance in its entirety may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk during regular working hours.

Pursuant to State Law, this item is to be reviewed by the Local Planning Agency and considered by the City Commission. As permitted by Section 163.3174 of the Florida Statutes, the City Commission also serves as the Local Planning Agency; therefore, the City Commission, both in their capacity as Local Planning Agency and as the governing body of the City will hear the item on Tuesday, January 16, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.
