FY 2025 Proposed Millage Rate, Assessments and Budgets for the City of Weston, Indian Trace Development District and Bonaventure Development District

City Manager Don Decker provided an introduction.

Director of Budget Bryan Cahen provided an overview of the FY 2025 proposed millage rate, assessments and budgets for the City, the Indian Trace Development District, and the Bonaventure Development District.
