The City Commission may continue or defer the hearing to a new date and time certain without further notice provided the date and time of the continuance or deferral is announced at the hearing. The Ordinances in their entirety may be inspected at the Office of the City Clerk during regular working hours.

Pursuant to Florida Statutes 286.0105, if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the City Commission with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

Any and all interested parties may appear at the above meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed items.
